

Request to Be a Guest on a Podcast or Radio Show

Below is an e-mail template for pitching a specific topic to listeners who fits your industry and who can learn from you further establishing you as a credible expert in your field. Note - This is an education pitch, where you are the teacher, and will "edutain" educate and entertain those that need to learn what you know.

First you want to search online any podcasts which host your topic. So if you teach marketing, you can go directly on iTunes for example and type: "podcasts on marketing, social media marketing, digital marketing." Then find the host. You can go to all the major podcast platforms and do this same search: Apple, BlogTalkRadio, Podbean, Spotify, Radio station site etc. Once you find a channel you feel fits your niche, reach out with the following e-mail template to the host. Note: Some podcasts do not list an e-mail to get in touch. You can google their name or find them on LinkedIn.

Subject: Speaking without Apology – a gutsy topic for listeners
